The physicians, management, and staff of Medical Center Clinic are saddened by the loss of beloved CEO and physician, Dr. Michael Redmond.

Dr. Redmond practiced as a Pediatric Ophthalmologist for 35 years at Medical Center Clinic and was compassionately devoted to the care and well-being of his patients. He was highly respected within the community and by his peers and colleagues.

Dedicated to his profession, Dr. Redmond served on the American Academy of Ophthalmology (AAO) Board of Trustees from 1993 to 2004. He was President Elect of the AAO in 2002, serving as President in 2003. Additionally, he served on the Florida Medical Association (FMA) Council on Legislation. Other Academy positions Dr. Redmond held were Representative to the American Medical Association's House of Delegates, Chairman of the EyeCare America Children's Project, Chairman of the Long-Range Planning Committee, member of the Ethics Committee, Ad Hoc Committee for Primary Eye Care, and Committee for State Governmental Affairs. He served as Assistant Clinical Professor of Medicine with Florida State University School of Medicine from 2008 to 2010.

Dr. Redmond received the FMA's highest award, the Certificate of Merit, for his outstanding service to the FMA, the medical profession, and the public.

A caring physician, Dr. Redmond always put his patients and others first. He will be greatly missed.
